

Oshkosh United Board Meeting Minutes - June 28, 2009

Motion made to approve minutes from May 31 meeting, seconded and approved.

President - First time using on-line registration went pretty well. There were some hiccups but we did get some feedback from people on it and hopefully it will go smoother next year. It also worked out well having wireless at the park for us to walk people through the process. Anyone with access to one that the club could borrow or donate to the club would be appreciated for next year. Also for try-outs please let all players trying out know that they will need to attend a try-out. If they cannot make the scheduled try-out time they will need to contact Chris and set up a time to be evaluated by one of our evaluators. We are in need of a Registrar and Secretary right now. Come November we will be re-electing the positions of Vice President and Secretary. Note that East Central is also looking for someone in Oshkosh to be the assistant regional registrar (this would be nice for anyone interested as far as processing cards).

Vice President - Mike is setting up a club survey and is looking for feedback as to what questions we would like to ask.

Treasurer - Financial were passed around. The financial for the tournament are not set/completed yet but it looks like we might turn a small profit this year. Also anyone winning their division does have the option of purchasing a trophy or T-shirt and it is \$15 per kid.

Director of Coaching - It was decided this year in place of a letter being sent out for people to accept/decline positions on teams that a group of people would get together and call players to offer them spots. A follow up letter will be sent out in addition to the phone call. Once Sean and Matt finalize rosters they will get in contact with this group.

New Business - The week of July 13, July 15, 16, 17 no practices or games out at County Park. East Central is offering clubs the option starting this fall to play a different league series of fall and spring instead of just a summer series for U14 and below, this fall would only be available to the U11/U12 teams. United will not participate in this part of East Central this fall. We have many issues to work out (fees, nets, goals, fields, field lining, coaches, etc.) and we have many questions for East Central as well (what are the rules as far as re-rostering players, league championship series, etc.) We will leave our fees as is for now and opt for teams to do the League Championship series so that the amount of games played will stay the same and so will the season timing. Mike will be going to the next East Central meeting with a list of questions that will hopefully help us understand and figure out where we need to go with this decision for next year.
